Covid-19 Safety Measures from September

In order to make sure that we continue to keep the whole school community safe, it is important that families keep us updated with information around positive Covid-19 cases.

Please ring the school office if your child develops any of the following symptoms:

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste

A Covid PCR test must be booked immediately. Do not send them to school.

I am currently in the process of writing our new school Covid-19 Risk Assessment; this will be based on Government guidance and therefore I am unable to share this with you at this stage. This will be shared with you when we return in September.

For the first day of term (Friday 3rd September 2021), I am going to ask that all children arrive for 8:40am; Senior Leaders will be outside to explain whether we will be continuing with the staggered start or not.

Although this is not compulsory, if parents/carers wish to continue to wear face coverings, we are happy for you to do so.
