LATE COLLECTION


Please collect your children on time at the end of the school day and from after school clubs. Staff members who look after the children also have appointments, children to collect and some are having to pay fines due to collecting their own children late whilst looking after yours. The Governors have agreed to start charging late fees for lateness.

First 5 minutes late after	No charge / grace
school or after a club	period
(1 off or the child is rarely collected late)	
5 minutes after grace	£5 charge

£5 for every 5 minutes thereafter
